

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO11068) affecting the A148 Fakenham Bypass from the A1067 Thorpland Roundabout to the A148 Creak Road Roundabout (the "Road") in the Town of Fakenham to facilitate road marking and lining, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 19:00 and 05:00 from the 27th to 29th April 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 10th June 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: A1065 Raynham Road / Gravelpit Hill /Swaffham Road / Fakenham Road, B1145 Lynn Road / Lexham Road / Back Street / Mileham Road / Litcham Road / The Street / Stanfield Road / Church Street / Elmham Road /Brisley Road, B1110 Holt Road, B1145 High Street / Broom Green Road / Broom Green / Bridge Road, A1067 Norwich Road / Langor Bridge / Pensthorpe Road / Clipbush Lane / Morrisons Roundabout, A148 Fakenham Bypass (Ryburgh, Fakenham, Wellingham, Guist, North Elmham, Litcham, Weasenham All Saints, Kettlestone, Raynham, Lexham, Brisley, Sculthorpe, Stanfield, Hempton, Weasenham St. Peter, Dunton, Mileham, Stibbard).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 10th June 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

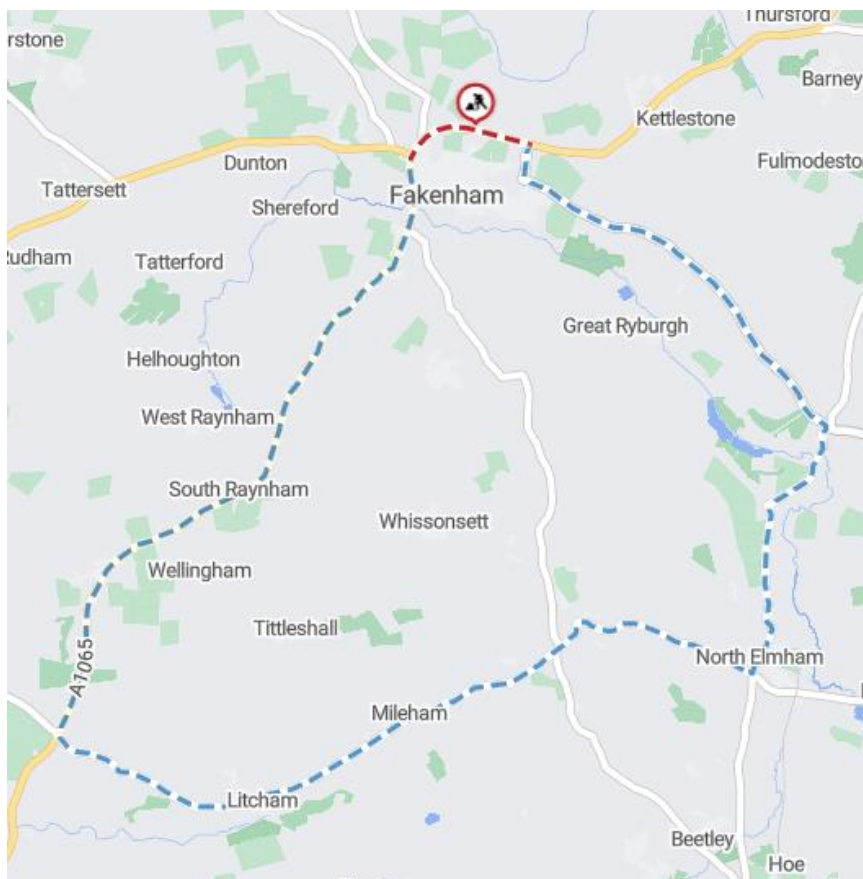
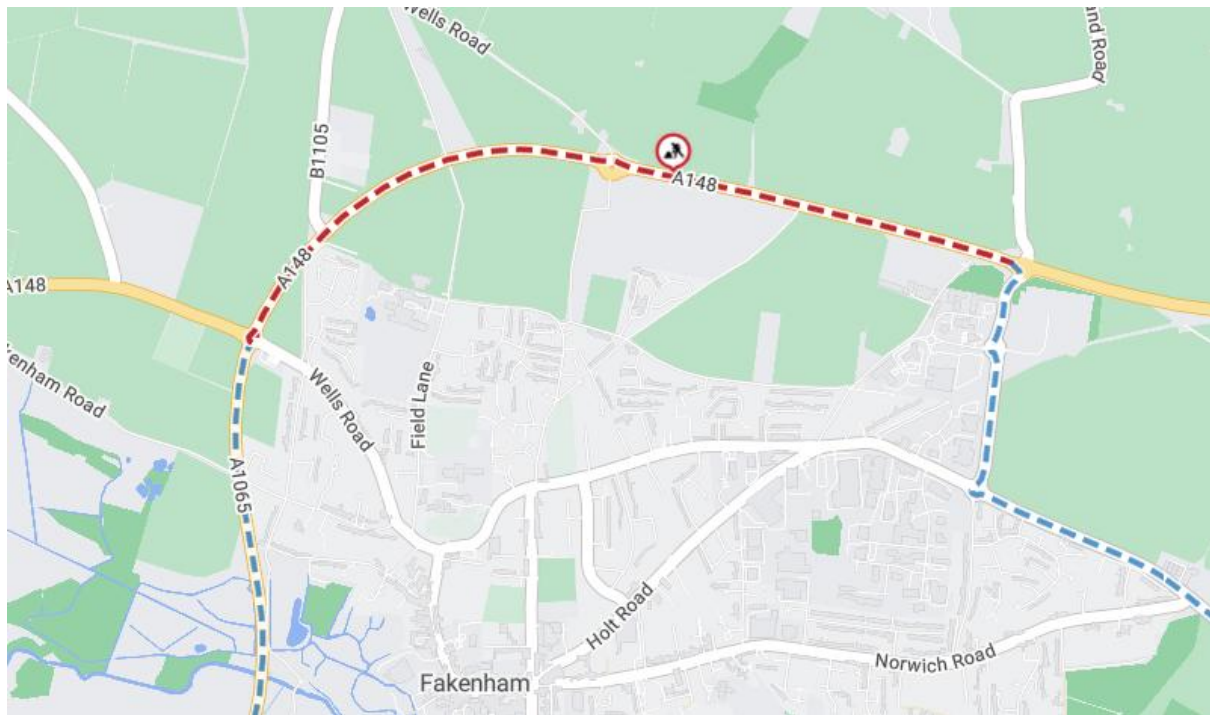
